

Baby Blossom

Materials Needed

2 different colored pieces of Grosgrain or ribbon of your choice in 3/8" cut in 9" pieces

A silk rosette for the center of your Baby Blossom

Take your ribbons and place them on top of one another, for this Baby Blossom I have the blue on the outside and the white going on the inside.



Take your ribbon, leave an inch hanging before you start and make a loop that will be the corner of your Baby Blossom.



Make another loop on the opposite side.



Turn your flower around so towards you and make your other two loops.



You can either put a stitch in the middle to hold this together or glue it, then cut off your excess ribbon and place your pretty silk flower rosette in the center and adhere your Baby Blossom to your clippie.
