


Froggie Bow

Take 1.5 ribbon. Cut 2 pieces approx. 7" for the legs, on the end of each of the ribbons, cut it on an angle. Measure 5 1/2" of ribbon for the froggies head, 6 1/2" for his body. Cut two pieces of ribbon 2 1/2" each for his eyes. You will also need two wiggle eyes, 1/4 or 3/8" ribbon cut in a 2" piece in pink or red for his tongue.



Make your basic bow for the froggies body. In the middle of the bow use your pink or red


ribbon to wrap around the center of the bow for his tongue.



Take one of the froggies legs and put it through one loop of the basic bow with the cut angel facing downward. Pull the top half of the ribbon over the back of your basic bow, glue the back of his leg to the front of his leg. Repeat on his other leg. Fold the ribbon for his head over and tie the bottom part of his so that you have one big loop. Attach his head to the back of the bow so that his head will just rest on top of the bow. Hot melt glue it in place.



Use the ribbon that you cut for the froggies eyes and fold it in half length wise. Glue together so that you have a strip of ribbon, now fold in half and clinch the ribbon and glue. This will be the be for your frogs eyes. It looks nicer when it is clinched because the frog a little definition for his eyes. Glue these ribbon on the back of the frogs head and adhere his wiggly/googlie eyes to them.

Baby Froggies

Make the baby froggies the same way but use $\frac{7}{8}$ " ribbon for the body e.t.c. and $\frac{3}{8}$ " for the tongue. The girl you can have a lot of fun with, I have given them hair bows on the side and have used korker ribbon for hair. I gave one of the girls blonde korker pigtails for hair with a bow on the side, it came out so cute!

Big Froggie Bow

It is the same way but I use 1.5" ribbon for his body, 3/8" for his tongue and the bow for his eye can be any size. Another cute way is to cut some corker ribbons about 2" and clinching them in the middle, wire them together and putting those on top or on the Froggie eye.

Froggie Face Bow

This is made like my "fruit" bows. Use 6" of 2.5" grosgrain ribbon. Fold over, glue together. Cut out a froggie's face, just the face! Glue on some googly eyes for his eyes or you can use black beads. I have used both and I like the way both turns out so I have no preference. Make a basic bow with tails in 1" ribbon, color of your choice and glue it to the bottom of the ribbon so it looks like he is wearing a bow on his neck, this also looks cute with a tuxedo bow!!
